



Unique to South Carolina
Rare Colonial Spanish horse breed
Significant to South Carolina history
Horse of choice for General Francis Marion
Ridden by Southern Confederate Cavalry in Civil War
Essential to Gullah and agricultural communities of the Lowcountry
Able to travel long distances with little fatigue
Able to survive on forage and marsh grass
Sure-footed in wooded and swampy areas
Adapt easily to human companions
Have a unique gait
Small and agile


